Chapter Heritage Grant Requirements

Overview

- Grants are provided by the Zeta Beta Tau Foundation and distributed by Zeta Beta Tau Fraternity up to \$1,500 per chapter. Amounts above \$1,500 may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Grant requests must be made at least a month in advance of scheduled program.
- Receipts for any expenses, pictures of the event and a text recap are required to be submitted.
- The Zeta Beta Tau Foundation must be formally recognized as a sponsor for the event.
- If making a request for a Shabbat dinner, a robust educational component is required, such as an external expert speaker.

Grant requests must fit into one of the following categories:

- Israel advocacy (i.e. Participating in a local AIPAC event, tabling for Israel on campus.)
- Israel education (i.e. Speaker on Israeli history, lecture from Israel education organizations)
- Jewish educational programming (lecture, discussion, Jewish book club)
- Internationally recognized ZBT days of remembrance:
 - Yom Ha'atzmaut (Israeli Independence Day)
 - Roger Williams Day (March 22)
 - Yom HaShoah (Holocaust Remembrance Day)
- Jewish, cultural, religious and educational programming (i.e. Sukkah building, lecture and discussion with a Rabbi, book club and discussion on a book on Jewish ethics).
- Antisemitism programming (i.e. Speaker on antisemitism, Holocaust education or BDS history, education and prevention).
- Social action programming (Community work with education in alignment with Tikkun Olam).

If partnering with another organization, a quote from the partner staff or officer should be included.

Helpful tips

- In the application, include a detailed explanation as to how the program fits the requirements.
- ZBT does not provide payment until AFTER the program occurs. This is a reimbursement-based program. The chapter or the partner organization will pay for the event and then submit the receipt(s) on the <u>Chapter Heritage Grant Feedback Form</u> to receive funds.
- Chapters are encouraged to invite local alumni and chapter advisor(s) to attend program.
- Chapters are encouraged to work with campus or local media for press coverage. Please send any published press or recognition of the event to ZBT International Headquarters.
