### Reach out to ZBT

Complete an expansion request.



2

### Connect on campus

Speak with the campus official who oversees the Greek community to let them know you want to bring ZBT to your campus, and why.

3

### Determine the process

Find out your school's policies and procedures for expansion.

*ZBT will only expand to a campus if given approval by the proper school officials.*



4

### Meeting Founding Fathers

If the school approves, ZBT will conduct initial interviews with each interested individual to ensure a proper fit. These initial joiners are called Founding Fathers of the new chapter.

### Expansion and alumni support

ZBT will plan an organized expansion effort which includes, recruitment, locating local chapter advisors and forming a board of advisors for the group, *before* the group is officially initiated.

## Second Semester

### Go big

ZBT and the Founding Fathers will work to grow the number of students interested in joining.

### Becoming a Prospective Chapter

The group will be initiated, begin THE JOURNEY (ZBT fraternity education), hold elections and attend national programs.

## Third & Fourth Semesters

### Earning a Charter

The Prospective Chapter will be supported by ZBT's Growth Team and continue to work towards chartering.

### Minimum requirements

When the group has met the chartering requirements, they petition the Supreme Council for recognition as a Chartered Chapter of ZBT. Requirements include size, financial stability, grades and more.

### It's official

Upon approval by the Supreme Council, the Chapter will hold a Chartering Ceremony and thereafter be a full ZBT chapter.



*Chapter housing will be secured after your Charter is granted. ZBT has a housing management division.*
